

We have received from many of you requests for more information than we are able to give. The Tennessee genealogical Society does not have holdings other than our "Master Surname Index", and the search of this file is a service offered only to members and subscribers (limit 4 names per request). There are in our group, professional researchers who work for a fee, and we will be happy to send their names and addresses if you enclose with your request a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

To aid your search we offer the following suggestions:

The Tennessee Department of Archives and History has published an Index for each county to show which records are available. Most of these records were filmed in the 1930's by the Genealogical Society of Utah, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84111. You may write the Tennessee State Library and Archives, Nashville, Tennessee 37219 for information concerning the index for the county in which you're working.

This issue contains an article on searching in a county whose records have been partially destroyed. We recommend that you study it.

BOOK REVIEWS

BEDWELL BEAUX AND BELLES, BOOK II, A Brief History of The Bedwell Family by Carolyn Reeves Ericson 1973. Hard backs. Over 150 pages. Order from Mrs. Joe Ericson, 1640 Redbud St., Nacogdoches, Texas 75961. \$10.00.

An outstanding feature of this continuation of Bedwell family history is the large number of photographs it contains. A large bibliography, which could prove useful to other researchers, is indicative of the care and time used by the author in preparing her work. The numbering system used is that recommended by The National Genealogical Society. There is much genealogical information in this publication.

BUTTON FAMILIES OF AMERICA, Compiled by R. Glen Nye. Edited by Katherine (Watson) Nye 1971. Hard backs. Over 941 pages. Indexed. Order from R. Glen Nye, 9369 Loren Drive, La Mesa, California 92041. \$16.50.

The book is a compilation of the Button family history for three hundred years without a break in the lineage, and it includes the various branches brought down to date. Many of the records go back over six hundred years. The first Button ancestor settled at Salem, Mass. However, there were two others, Robert and John Button of Boston, who were contemporaries of the Salem settler, Matthias Button. These two were not affiliated, but their family records and history are carried to the third generation. The Button family, whose name is of French origin, is found over much of the United States.

ARCHIVES OF THE PIONEERS OF TAZEWELL COUNTY, VIRGINIA transcribed and edited by Netti Schrivner-Yantis 1973. Hard covers. Over 346 pages. Indexed. Order from the author, 6818 Lois Drive, Springfield, Va. 22150. \$22.50.

The author states that "The purpose of this work is to locate, assemble, completely index, and make available in one volume the archives of the people who lived in Tazewell County a century and a half ago". She has done so. A great portion of the publication is a transcript of primary records, i.e. order book, tax lists, petitions, executive papers, land grants, wills and marriages, in addition to much other information. The result is the most extensive list of names and other pertinent information ever seen by this reviewer assembled in one publication. Are your ancestors from the 'Bootheel of Virginia'? You can probably find them, or a trace of them, here.

THE GENEALOGICAL HISTORY OF THE THOMAS DAWSON FAMILY AND ITS DESCENDANTS IN AMERICA by Everett T. Dawson 1974. Hard backs. Over 256 pages. Indexed. Order from the author, 4107 Jefferson Street, Austin, Texas 78731. \$19.00.

This work is a love offering from the author to his family. It is well done and easily used by anyone. Perhaps you will find the person you are looking for in this genealogy. The family started, among many other Scotch-Irish, in West Caln Township, Chester County, Penn. It was successively found in Frederick and Hampshire Counties, Va., Clark County, Ky., Ralls County, Mo., and Ellis County, Texas. Associated families are: Constant, Christy, Judy, Burroughs, Ball, Craycraft, Crain, Donaldson, Coder, Correll, Colwell, Nichols, Goldsberry, Hawkins, Owens, Prather, Pyles, and Wood.

THE EDWARDS OF NORTHAMPTON by Bruce Montgomery Edwards 1973. Hard covers. Over 315 pages. Indexed. Order from Montgomery Publishing Co., Box 5504, Knoxville, Tenn. 37918. \$8.40.

The Edwards of Northampton came from Wales where the ancestral home, "Edwards Hall", was built about 1050-1100 in the time of William the Conqueror. The family record begins with Richard Edwards and is traced through his great-great grandson, Thomas, the father of seven sons of whom Robert, John and Jacob came to America about 1750. John's son, Samuel, is the ancestor of this Edwards family in America and Virginia, and from him the author has recorded the history of his family.

OKLAHOMA INDIAN TERRITORY by Ted Byron Hall 1971. Hard backs. Over 752 pages. Indexed. Order from the author, 1320 Jamestown Drive, Tahlequah, Oklahoma 74464. \$25.00.

This volume is well written and an excellent family history. The 18 maps and 28 photographs contribute much to a comprehensive history and genealogy, and the excellent footnotes testify to extensive research. The history of the Hall family in Gibson County, Tenn., their move to Western Ark., then to the Indian Territory of Oklahoma depicts a fascinating pattern of early American family movements. The author uniquely describes the life and times of Oklahoma from before the Civil War until Statehood. The tales of Belle Starr, the exploring expeditions, the old trading trails, the beginnings of Whitefield, the Civil War in Indian Territory, and the families whose genealogies are given, all make a very interesting publication.

ISAAC SHELBY: KENTUCKY'S FIRST GOVERNOR AND HERO OF THREE WARS by Sylvia Wrobel and George Grider, 1974. Hard backs. Over 153 pages. Not indexed. Order from George Grider, President Cumberland Press, P.O. Box 876, Danville, Ky. 40422. \$12.50.

Isaac Shelby was born Dec. 11, 1750 in Maryland. His grandparents, Evan and Catherine Shelby, were born in Wales, as was his father, Evan, Jr. After financial success and failure in Maryland, Evan, Jr. moved his family to what is now the Holston Country of Tenn. He built a strong log house and fort, which was set right on the path to Kentucky and Boone's famous Wilderness Trail. This trail was an open dare for Isaac, and soon he was traveling it westward. He went to Kentucky when it was only a wilderness and stayed to help lead it to statehood. Isaac Shelby's military career included participation in Lord Dunmore's War, the Revolution, and the Indian Wars of East Tennessee. When Kentucky became a state, he was called from his farming interests at Traveler's Rest to be the first governor. After serving his first term, he went back to Traveler's Rest only to be recalled by the unrest of the War of 1812 to the governorship again. After leading Kentucky troops at the battle of Thames in Canada, he returned to Traveler's Rest, where he died July 18, 1826. The book is an enjoyable record of this Shelby family, as well as a record of its famous patriot, statesman and pioneer.

SKETCHES AND GENEALOGY OF THE BAILEY-CRADDICK-LAWSON FAMILIES OF VIRGINIA AND NORTH CAROLINA; with notes on the families of Coleman, DuVal, Scott, Easley, Madison, Lanier, Allen, Hunt, Wimbish, Traynham, Ragland and Barksdale. Compiled by Betsy Lawson Willis and Martha Barksdale Craddock. Soft covers. Over 218 pages. Indexed. Order from Betsy Lawson Willis, 104 Commonwealth Ave., Alexandria, Va. 22301.

The authors have done a tremendous amount of research in preparing this genealogy of their families. The book includes many of the early families of Virginia.

THE FILE BOX
by Jerry Blair (Mrs. W. R.)

One of our readers from North Carolina was kind enough to send us some LINSTER records which will be of interest to many who are working on Tennessee genealogies as the LINSTERS (some spellings show it LISTER) are related to many early Tennesseans. I quote the following from an old family record in possession of Mrs. Goodman of Ulla, North Carolina:

"Moses Linster, b. Nov. 1, 1740, in County of Cavan, Ireland, d. 2 July, 1817. Sarah Wells, wife of Moses Linster, b. July 4, 1747, in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, d. Dec. 12, 1818. Moses and Sarah were married ca. 1768-9. Their children were:

1. Margaret Linster, born Nov. 11, 1770; died December 11, 1840
2. Sarah Linster, born 1782
3. Thomas Wells Linster, b. Nov. 27, 1789

Margaret Linster married Joseph Hall, Aug. 22, 1793, in Rowan County, North Carolina. Both are buried in the Hall Burial Ground at Jerusalem in Davie County, N. C.

Land grants in the Secretary of State's Office in Raleigh, N. C. show at least six grants dating from 1780 to 1800 entered by LINSTERS. Grant No. 791 was entered in 1778 showing Moses Linster to be in Rowan County on that date. Rowan was formerly Anson County so we see that Moses Linster and his wife settled there during the Revolutionary War on the east side of the South Yadkin River. Their son, Thomas Wells Linster, sold his inheritance in North Carolina (Rowan County Deed Book 25, page 621) and moved to Tennessee in 1819 (Rutherford County) where he married Mary Campbell, born September 13, 1802, in Rutherford County, Tennessee. Her parents were Samuel and Nancy Mann Campbell. Mary Campbell Linster died May 9, 1859 and is buried in the East Vine Street cemetery in Murfreesboro, Tenn. The children of Mary (Campbell) and Thomas W. Linster were Ann Eliza Linster, born May 2, 1821, and Margaret Linster, born 1825.

Ann Eliza Linster married E. C. Slater, a Baptist minister and had three children: Elizabeth, who married a Mr. Ransom; Thomas, unmarried; and Margaret, unmarried. Descendants of Ann Eliza Linster Slater live in Murfreesboro today. The will of Mary Campbell Linster is recorded in Rutherford County Record Book 20, page 77, and was probated June 6, 1859. Her brother Samuel Campbell was Executor. She left her property to daughter Margaret Linster Watkins, who married in 1851 Joseph Magruder Watkins, and to the three children of her deceased daughter, Ann Eliza Linster Slater, whose children were Elizabeth, Thomas and Mary Margaret Slater.

The lineage of Mary Campbell (Linster) descendant of Archibald Campbell and Elizabeth (Baker) Campbell were sent to us by our correspondent. She states a record of Archibald Campbell in Bedford County, Virginia in 1754, Dec. Court Order Book 1-A, page 52, lists him under a list of "Tyths," and in 1760, Bedford County Deed Book 1, p. 312, he buys land from James Walker on both sides of the North fork of Falling River, on a dividing line between "said Campbell and Charles Simmons."

From William Crozier's VIRGINIA MILITIA, Bedford County, Virginia, September 1758, page 68, List of Militia shows Archibald Campbell et al, as Colonial soldiers. A land warrant for this service was signed by Thomas Jefferson. There are other Campbell records available in Virginia, but in 1796 Archibald Campbell bought land in Greene County, Tennessee as indicated by Greene County Deed Book 6, page 65, dated October 1796: "James Robinson deed to Archibald Campbell, the Indenture made and concluded upon this day of October 1796, between James Robinson of Greene County and Archibald Campbell of Knox County, Tennessee, for 80 pounds of Virginia currency -- land in the county of Knox on the south side of Holston River on

Robinson Creek . . . to Doak's corner . . . 2000 acres." In 1802, March 11, Archibald Campbell and his wife Elizabeth were living in Knox County, Tennessee, on Robinson's Creek, now Clift Creek. Archibald made his will in 1801. Children of Archibald Campbell and Elizabeth Baker Campbell were:

1. Agnes Campbell Hall, b. Bedford Co., Va., ca. 1757; m. Charles Hall
2. James Campbell, b. Bedford Co., Va., ca. 1759; m. April 27, 1784, in Campbell County, Va., to Jane Means; Will dated 2-18-1826 filed in Dandridge, Jefferson Co., Tennessee.
3. John Campbell, b. Bedford Co., Va., 1761, m. Sarah Vance in 1796. He lived in Tennessee until 1817 but moved to Preble Co., Ohio, where he died in 1847. For his family see "History of Preble Co., Ohio," by H. Z. Williams.
4. Elizabeth Campbell Hall, b. Bedford Co., Va., ca. 1763, m. Wm. Hall March 5, 1787 in Campbell Co., Va.
5. Janet born Va. 1765, m. 1794 Samuel McReynolds, son of James McReynolds of Campbell Co., Va.
6. William Campbell, b. Bedford Co., 1767, m. Luraney Ledbetter, dau. of Joseph Ledbetter of Campbell County in Jan. of 1799.
7. Samuel Campbell born Bedford Co., 1769, m. Mrs. Nancy Mann Fleming, widow of Peter Fleming, in Campbell Co., Va., on November 13, 1797.
8. Mary Campbell born Bedford Co., ca. 1771, m. July 14, 1800, John Fleming.

James, John, and William Campbell all came to Tennessee with their father. Samuel Campbell remained in Va., presumably to look after his father's lands, until 1802 when he, too, bought land in Tennessee.

Rutherford County, Tennessee was formed from Davidson Co., Oct. 25, 1803, and a tract of 951 acres purchased by Samuel Campbell in 1802 when he moved to Tennessee was cut off into Rutherford County. The 1810 Census for Rutherford Co., Tennessee (page 26) lists Samuel Campbell as head of a family with 4 sons and 4 daughters and 10 slaves. He is mentioned several times in the Minute Books of 1811. Samuel Campbell died September 7, 1846 without a will, and a son-in-law was appointed administrator. A settlement was signed by M. B. Wade, administrator, Jan. 28, 1847. The following is a record of Samuel Campbell's family copied from his Bible owned by a descendant in Murfreesboro, Tennessee:

JAMES BRADLEY CEMETERY
Contributed by Robert Young Clay, Richmond, Va.

This cemetery is located across Lovers Lane from the James Bradley home, just off Highway 25, east of Dixon Springs, Smith Co., Tenn. It is enclosed by a sturdy stone wall on the cornerstone of which are the words, "James Bradley Family Graves". Within the wall are three large box tombs with no inscriptions, several fieldstone markers, and the following inscribed stones:

RESEARCH AIDS IN BURNED COUNTIES IN TENNESSEE
By Thomas P. Hughes, Jr.

Fifty-five Tennessee counties have lost some or all of their records due to storm, fire, or destruction by Union troops. For records that are available on microfilm, check "INDEX OF TENNESSEE COUNTY COURTHOUSE RECORDS PRIOR TO 1860, SELECTED COUNTIES" on page 69 of "ANSEARCHIN'" NEWS, Vol. I-VI (1954-1959), and for records copied by W.P.A., see "TENNESSEE COUNTY RECORDS AVAILABLE IN THE TENNESSEE STATE LIBRARY, NASHVILLE on page 109 of "ANSEARCHIN'" NEWS, Vol. I-VI.¹

If the records you seek have been destroyed, the following sources of information are available to you.

1. **TAX LISTS.** Each county sent these lists to the state capital, and the lists, therefore, have been preserved. They are on microfilm at the Tennessee State Library and Archives in Nashville. Also, many tax lists, especially for early years, have been published in "ANSEARCHIN'" NEWS, the East Tennessee Historical Society publication, and other quarterlies. Tables of contents for all volumes of "ANSEARCHIN'" NEWS are sent free on request, and published tax lists are shown therein. Tax lists published by the East Tennessee Historical Society are listed below, together with the volume number and year of the issue in which they appeared.

4. **SURROUNDING COUNTIES.** Your ancestor's will will be recorded in every county where he owned land; so be sure to check surrounding counties for wills and estate records (settlements, divisions of property, etc.)

5. PARENT COUNTY. Always consult whatever handbook you are using to determine the year the burned county was formed and from what county or counties it was made. The record you need may be in one of the parent counties, depending on the date of the record you seek.
6. TITLE COMPANY. Title companies -- located in Chattanooga, Knoxville, Nashville, and Memphis -- have land records of the county where they are located, plus limited records of adjoining counties. The company will trace ownership of property (and furnish what supporting documents they may have) for a substantial fee. You must offer some clue -- other than the name of your ancestor -- to enable the company to make this search. Tax bills or receipts, an old deed, or probate record would indicate the location of the property.
7. CHANCERY COURTS. Minutes of court proceedings of the Divisions of the Chancery Courts, set up under the 1835 State Constitution, may be found in the location where the court was held. The 1835 Divisions are shown below, followed by a listing of the Divisions of Chancery Court under the 1870 State Constitution, when the counties were regrouped.

During his second tour from Orange Co. he served under Capt. William Williamson, Capt. Taylor. After this tour he "took a certain deserter prisoner by the name of John Kelland" and on turning him in, received a discharge for 3 months. His third tour was under Col. Tannell (?) and Capt. Williams. His fourth tour was under Capt. James Falker and Col. Nathaniel Rochester.

Thomas Raegans can prove his services. Pensioner moved from Orange Co., N.C. to Williamson Co., Tenn. in 1799.

RECORDS OF THE RAINS FAMILY OF DAVIDSON CO. TENNESSEE

Copied from Tennessee Records of Davidson County, Wills and Inventories, Vol. 8

Rains, Naomi, deceased, Will, Page 18.

"In the name of God, Amen. I, Naomi Rains of Davidson County and State of Tennessee, being of sound and disposing memory but calling to mind the certainty of death, do hereby make and ordain and establish this my only and last will and testament. First I command my soul to God its creator.....As to the worldly goods which God has pleased to bestow on me, I give and bequeath as follows: (1) my land interest more or less I give and bequeath to my mother Ursula Rains during her natural life and at her death the same to be equally divided between all my brothers and sisters, share and share alike. (2) my undivided interest also in the Negro or Slave estate I give and bequeath unto my said mother forever to be by her disposed as she may think proper.....I hereby appoint my said mother Ursula Rains my executrix.....this 26th day of April....1821....in the presence of R. C. Foster and Wilford H. Rains.

State of Tennessee, Davidson County Court July Session 1821-- The last will and testament of Naomi Rains, deceased, being exhibited in court for probate was proven thus 'Robert C. Foster and Wilford H. Rains subscribing witnesses to said will being duly sworn and saying they became such in the presence of the testatrix and at her request and in the presence of each other and that they believe said testatrix was in her right mind at the time of executing said last will. Ordered that said will and this probate be recorded at length.'"

Rains, Wilford H. Page 158.

We the undersigned being appointed by the worshipful Court of Davidson Co. Commissioners to divide and set apart to Welford H. Rains one of the heirs of William Rains, deceased, his portion as heir of William Rains to 200 acres of land and 10 Negroes. We have in conformity to said order went on the premises and ascertained by measurement the quantity of land which said William Rains held by deed from his father, John Rains, which deed is dated October 16, 1795 and find from the calls of said deed that it contains 221 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres. We have lid off and set apart to said Welford H. Rains out of said tract 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land as his portion which is bounded as follows:.....Also we have set apart to said Welford H. Rains one negro boy about 13 years of age named George as his equal portion.....on condition of his paying to the other heirs the sum of...twenty-two and one third dollars....Given under our hands and seals this 10 day of September 1822. Sworn to before me this 10 day of September 1832.
